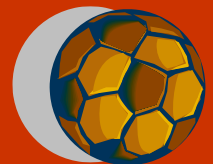
Volunteer opportunities are available at four different elementary school sites:

- One-on-one reading tutor for 2nd and 3rd graders
- Math tutors
- Classroom assistants
- Activity leaders (teaching a skill)
- Enrichment Activities
- Homework assistants
- Lunch buddy



Criteria and Commitment Levels:

- Must pass Tacoma School District background check
- Must have a passion for helping kids
- The ability to work with a wide variety of people
- Commitment level one: 1 or more hours per week for 10 weeks
- Commitment level two: 1 or more hours per week during the school year (approximately 30 weeks) for reading or math tutoring or enrichment programs
